R2M This credential authorizes the holder to teach all subjects in a self-contained class and, as a self-contained classroom teacher, to team teach or to regroup students across classrooms, in grades twelve and below, including preschool, and in classes organized primarily for adults. In addition, this credential authorizes the holder to teach core classes consisting of two or more subjects to the same group of students in grades five through eight, and to teach any of the core subjects he or she is teaching to a single group of students in the same grade level as the core for less than fifty percent of his or her work day.

R2B This credential authorizes the holder to teach single-subject-matter (departmentalized) courses within the field of the supplementary authorization named above in grades nine and below.

Valid: May 26, 2004 to November 1, 2006

R12D To renew this credential the holder must complete the following requirements, which are explained in detail on the enclosed leaflet: methods of developing English language skills, including reading, provisions and principles of the U.S. Constitution, subject-matter competence, health education, special education, computer education. When all requirements have been completed, the holder will be eligible for a professional clear credential that will include the completion of professional growth and service requirements as a condition for each five-year renewal.


