Learning Log Guide:

- REMEMBER!** This is a **LEARNING LOG**, not a **DOING LOG**. I don't want to know what you did in class. I want to know what you **LEARNED**. For example, if you watched a movie in class... What was the topic of the movie and what was the most memorable part? In other words, what did you learn from watching the movie. Refer to *example 1* below:
- Think of each box as valuable real estate. Maximize the information you fit in each. To accomplish this remember to include:
 - What you learned
 - An example or more specific information

Example 1

M O N		We watched a pollution movie.	BAD! This tells me what you DID . Or that you learned how to watch a movie... Really? Is that what you learned?
	T U E	Hydrocarbon: A chemical compound that contains carbon and hydrogen. They are combustible. The most abundant hydrocarbon is methane.	GOOD! This clearly tells me what you learned from watching the movie about pollution. It also provides specific information about what you learned. In mathematics you will more likely give an example.

Every week:

- Use Inspiration to convert your learning log into a mind map.
- Use Dreamweaver and the prompt provided to create an entry in your writing log.
- After completing 1 and 2, start working on the module you've chosen. Be prepared to write about your progress. For instance, if your module is Robotics, write about what you did towards solving the problem you were given. Look at the *example 2* below.
- Fill in a score for: 1) Module Progress, 2) Learning Log, 3) Writing Log, 4) Mind Map, and 5) Citizenship.
- Complete **PART I** of the online assessment form. Pass your learning log to the student on your left and have them complete **PART II**. You must agree on the grade before submitting. If there is a dispute, ask the teacher to resolve it.
